The world would be a better place if...



Reflect on the theme. Create an original work. Be recognized!

Use the theme: *The world would be a better place if...* to create a work of art: a drawing, a painting, a photograph, a collage (cut and pasted clippings, photos, etc), or a computer-generated artwork.

The following are the rules. If your artwork does not follow all of these, it will still be in Northmont's competition, but it cannot be entered into the district, state, or national competitions.

Your artwork must be done by you and only you. Because Reflections is about you expressing your creativity, your parents or other people cannot work on your artwork.

This needs to be your original artwork, so don't use anything copyrighted. For example, you didn't create Mickey Mouse, so he shouldn't be in your artwork.

No sculptures or three-dimensional artwork.

Your artwork must be mounted on something sturdy like posterboard, cardboard, or matboard that is less than 3/8 inch thick.

Your artwork and the matting must be less than 24x30 inches, and photographs must be less than 11x14 inches after mounting.

Put your name on the back; don't sign the front.

Fill out the entry form completely (everything except the PTA box at the bottom).

After your artwork is done, think carefully about your title and artist's statement. They will be judged too! They must be written by you, or told to an adult who writes your words exactly.

All artwork must be turned in to your teacher or the office by October 3.
